U.S.A. FOUGHT WWII TO FREE ALL NATIONS.  
IN 1946, HELPED FRANCE RECOLONIZE VIETNAM.

1954: WE TAKE OVER FRANCE'S WAR  
1965: 200,000 U.S. TROOPS IN VIETNAM

ECUADOR HAS CHANGED GOVERNMENTS 86 TIMES SINCE  
INDEPENDENCE IN 1830. WE OFTEN HELPED.

1960: BANANA BOOM FADES; ECONOMY CRASHES  
1964: U.S. COMPANIES WIN OIL RIGHTS

INDONESIA PRODUCED COFFEE, RUBBER, TOBACCO, AND A  
LARGE STARVING CLASS UNDER DUTCH RULE, 1620-1942.

1950's-60's: PRESIDENT SUKARNO ANGERS FOREIGN  
INVESTORS  
1965: CIA ASSISTS COUP; 500,000 KILLED

PANAMA SECEDED FROM COLOMBIA IN 1903, BACKED BY U.S..  
IN 1904, AGREED U.S. SHOULD BUILD A CANAL.

1914-77: U.S. CONTROLS PANAMA CANAL  
1977: TORRIJOS NEGOTIATES NEW CANAL TREATY; GAINS  
SOVEREIGNTY

IRAN WAS OVERRUN BY GREEKS, MONGOLS, ARABS, TURKS, RUSSIANS, AND  
BRITISH. WE CAME IN 1941.

1951: PRIME MINISTER MOSSADEQ NATIONALIZES OIL  
1953: CIA OUSTS MOSSADEQ
